Mission Statement:

Raphael House is dedicated to helping at-risk children and their families achieve stable housing and financial independence, while strengthening family bonds and personal dignity. From the moment a family enters the doors of this home, until long after they depart to stable housing, Raphael House offers the resources and relationships necessary for parents and children to embrace a secure and fulfilling life.

History:

Established in 1971 as the first shelter in San Francisco for homeless families, Raphael House has a dedicated staff and Board of Directors from the local community, along with a small core of Orthodox Christian live-in staff. No religious obligations are placed on the families we serve. Raphael House relies solely on private sources to meet its annual budget. Support is received from individuals, businesses and corporations, foundations, church groups, and civic organizations that are committed to promoting stability for at-risk families. We do not seek nor accept federal, state, or municipal funding.

By enlisting the support of the community for our work, Raphael House sets in motion a cycle of renewal. During the past 38 years, we have sheltered more than 17,000 children and their parents; and more than 12,000 individuals have invested financial and volunteer support to assist Raphael House.

Raphael House is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation.

RESIDENTIAL SHELTER PROGRAM

Families arrive at our doors in crisis but committed to full participation in the Residential Shelter Program. Our program removes uncertainty and fills the most basic human needs of shelter, food, and clothing. Raphael House builds a sense of trust whereby families can begin to rebuild their lives, focusing on their goals within a supportive and deeply caring community.



AFTERCARE PROGRAM

As families move to stable housing within the community, Raphael House offers systematic follow-up through our comprehensive AfterCare Program. The goal of this program is to help families maintain their stability by providing long-term case management, material resources, and social and educational outings to help them transition from the protective shelter environment to independence. This program creates a long-term healthy community, where children and parents can continue their connection to Raphael House, long after they have left the shelter.



STEPS TO STABLE HOUSING:

- ◆ Upon arrival each family is assigned a caseworker who becomes their ally and guide for the time of their stay.
- ◆ At the 15-day mark the caseworker and family review realistic goals for their children, employment, housing, education, and more.
- ◆ By the 45-day review, every family has a clear exit strategy that is close to completion.
- ◆ We charge nominal fees per day: \$3 per adult and \$2 per child. No family pays more than \$12.
- ◆ Families are required to save 80% of their income.
- ◆ Families stay in one of 17 private bedrooms.
- ◆ Up to 50 residents live at Raphael House at any given time.

Last year, the Residential Shelter Program served **102 families**, totaling **336 individuals**, of which **202** were children.

Core Programs

CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

The Children's Program is the core of all Raphael House services, and in fact, our approach is to create our model "through the eyes of a child." A strong daily structure allows children to anticipate events and people within their environment, giving them a sense of security. Daily routines are crucial to the children's healing, and we focus on developing creativity and imagination through stories, songs, games, dance, and arts and crafts activities. Our Children's Program works closely with both children and their parents, using the tools of structure and play. We try to restore a child's sense of respect, wonder and cooperation in the face of an often chaotic and unpredictable world.

Raphael House served **1,611** children through the Residential Shelter and AfterCare Programs.



AFTERSCHOOL TUTORING PROGRAM

Academic support is crucial for children experiencing homelessness because they are at a higher risk of falling behind in school.

Through the Afterschool Program, Raphael House provides academic support services for children who are in shelter and AfterCare.

- ♦ Four-to-one tutoring, or for those students facing academic challenges, one-on-one tutoring is also available.
- ♦ The objective of the program is to help children succeed academically by providing consistency and a strong support system.
- ♦ We focus on developing and reinforcing reading skills. Children in the program are required to read at least twenty minutes every day.

Last year, every child in the Afterschool Program advanced to the next grade level, showed academic improvement, and received higher teacher ratings at the end of the year (compared to the beginning).

Last year, **29** children in 21 families participated in the Afterschool Tutoring Program.

Volunteers

About 2,300 individuals participate in one or more volunteering opportunities each year.

While residents and staff members participate in the daily chores required to run our "household," many community volunteers are also needed to ensure Raphael House runs smoothly. Fortunately, we have an abundance of community volunteers - more than 2,300 of them - who routinely pitch in. The diverse volunteers from the San Francisco community include teens, seniors, professionals, and former residents. In addition, a group of live-in volunteers participate in our three to nine month internship program, which draws people from all over the world. Volunteers assist in every aspect of Raphael House daily life, as well as helping with special projects.

The **Housing First** Program Continues to Thrive with the Help of the *Charles and Helen Schwab Foundation*

What is Housing First?

In 2005, Raphael House instituted a new initiative, with the help of the Charles and Helen Schwab Foundation, to help people move into housing faster. The philosophy is that families need housing first and foremost, and with ongoing care and support they can address the other issues that have been keeping them in poverty, including education, unemployment, childcare, and emotional trauma. The Housing First initiative helps families pay for expenses that are barriers to housing, such as security deposits, outstanding bills, or credit report applications. This initiative has had a dramatic effect on our ability to move people into permanent housing and out of homelessness. These families then become part of our AfterCare Program to support any additional needs they may face.

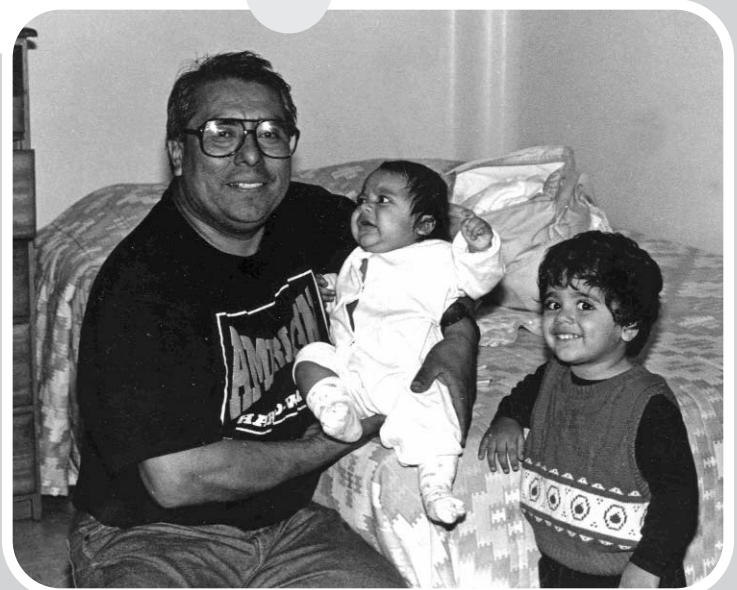
Housing First Facts

- ◆ Since 2005, we have moved **214 families** into stable housing
- ◆ **94%** have remained in stable housing
- ◆ On average, each family has received \$1,714.00
- ◆ The total cost amounts to only 4% of the Raphael House operating budget
- ◆ The annual number of families served in the Residential Program jumped from 37 to 102 in 5 years
- ◆ Shelter stays decreased from an average of 118 days to 29 days
- ◆ Success rate of moving families into stable housing remained consistent at 81-84 percent

“ My family has been living in a garage for the last year and with the help of Raphael House we have bought into a cooperative so that we are share holders in permanent, affordable housing. ”

“ We got caught up in the home buyer frenzy and lost our house when the market crashed. With the help of Raphael House we did not become homeless but were able to rent an apartment. ”

“ I was fleeing domestic violence, had to move to another county, and Children’s Protective Services was ready to remove my three children from the home if Raphael House had not assisted me with the funds to move into another housing situation. ”



What's New?

ChildReach Program Expands Teen Activities

Last year, **52 teens** participated in activities such as whitewater rafting, a teen camping trip to Samuel P. Taylor Park, music classes, karate classes, and hiking trips.

Seventeen teens have voluntarily signed up for Weekend Tutoring at Raphael House. **Seven** of those teens have committed to receive tutoring three Saturdays per month, have set academic and personal goals, and will be rewarded for their achievement with a trip to Washington, DC next summer.

Raphael House knows the importance of reducing poverty for our families by providing as much academic support as possible for children to advance to the next grade level, graduate high school, and continue on to college. This is a key strategy in our efforts to end the cycle of poverty and homelessness.

A total of 498 teens are served through our AfterCare and Residential Programs.



Weekend Tutoring Services

Fortunately, Raphael House has some funds to provide scholarships to children for private tutoring; however, we are unable to provide every child with this opportunity. In response, Raphael House established a weekend tutoring program for AfterCare children who need additional academic support and are not receiving tutoring services from other agencies.

The children's ages range from 8 to 14, therefore, the subject matter varies greatly. We are fortunate to have a group of volunteers who have the skill sets to meet the needs of each child. They have helped students with everything from 4th grade math to the preparation of a 9th grade English class essay.

We are very proud of the success of the tutoring program and have begun to offer tutoring three Saturdays per month.

Parent Group

Raphael House recently established a Parent Group, which creates an ongoing dialogue with former residents. It consists of monthly meetings with former resident parents and will act as a "PTA" for Raphael House. The goal of the Parent Group is to better understand the needs of former residents; expand services based on those needs; and get parents more involved in the operation of the ChildReach and AfterCare programs. Additionally, this will create a network between parents and add to the support system Raphael House strives to provide.

We have learned that engaging parents and providing them with additional ownership in creating opportunities for themselves and their children has resulted in projects that are more dynamic, exciting, well-developed and better suited to their needs. A special moment during one of the meetings was when a parent described the Raphael House AfterCare Program as the "ultimate hands of a grandparent."

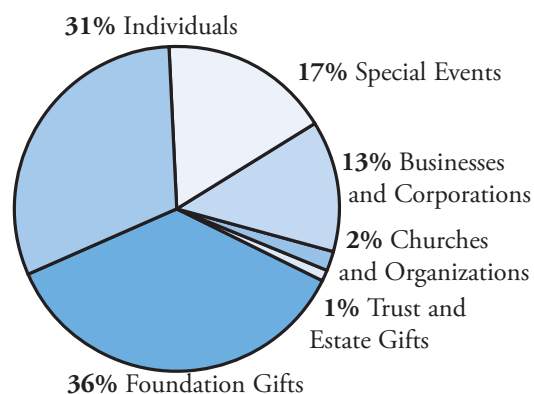

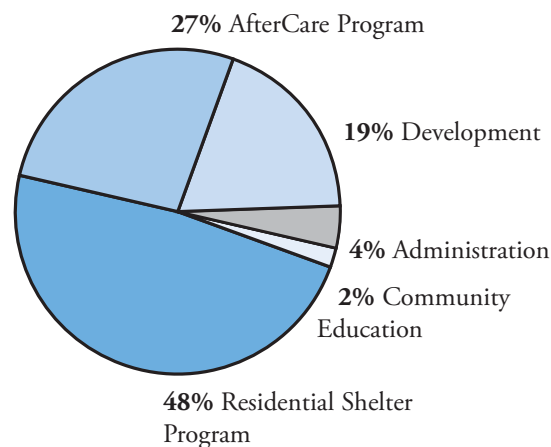
Income by Source

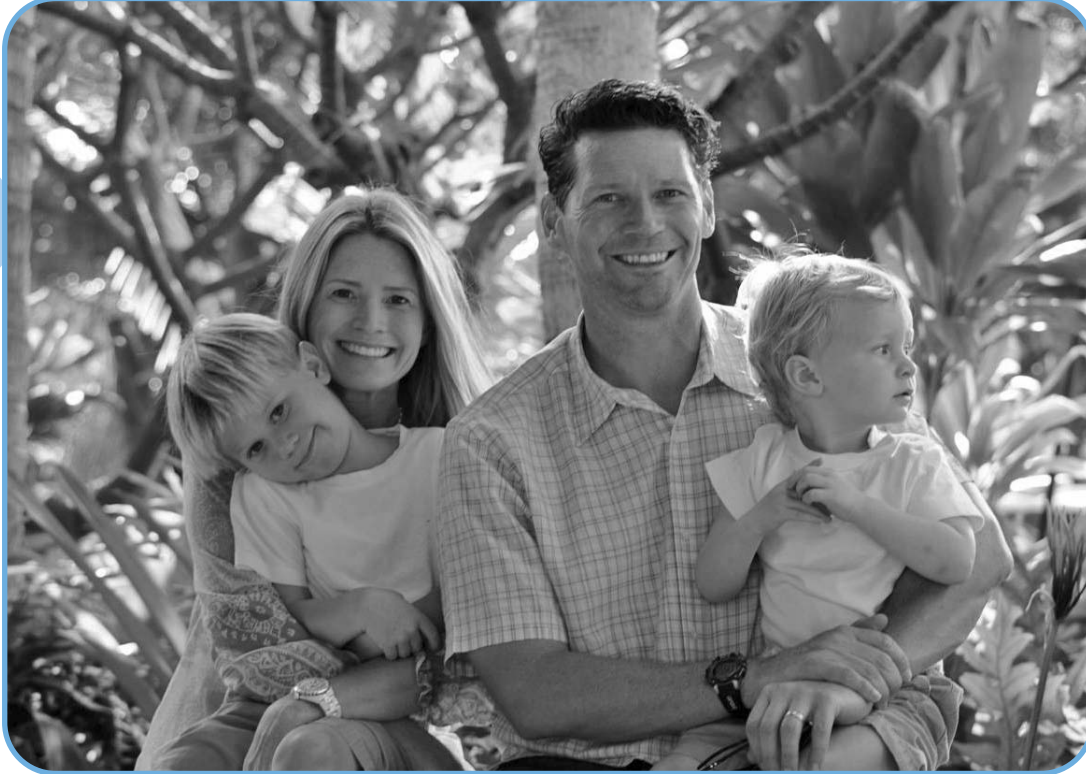

Raphael House Establishes an Endowment Fund

In the Spring of 2008, Raphael House Board Member, Ann-Ferrell Millham and her husband Steve, made an extraordinary contribution to Raphael House to start an endowment fund. For the year that followed, the Millhams once again showed their incredible generosity by providing a matching gift opportunity for the Raphael House Endowment Fund. Thanks to the Millhams, and to the many generous donors who made endowment gifts as part of this matching campaign, nearly \$1.4 million has been raised for the endowment.

The Millhams have been affiliated with Raphael House for many years through their participation in our annual “One Home, Many Hearts” Gala. In fact, Ann-Ferrell chaired the event in 2004 and currently sits on the Raphael House Board of Directors. By volunteering for the gala and further learning about the work of the organization, Ann-Ferrell and Steve felt like they were part of a large family. “At the time I was getting involved with Raphael House, Steve and I were just beginning a family ourselves,” says Ann-Ferrell. “Watching families who are truly trying to help themselves was an inspiration to us.”

The mission of Raphael House resonated with Ann-Ferrell’s sense of family and community. 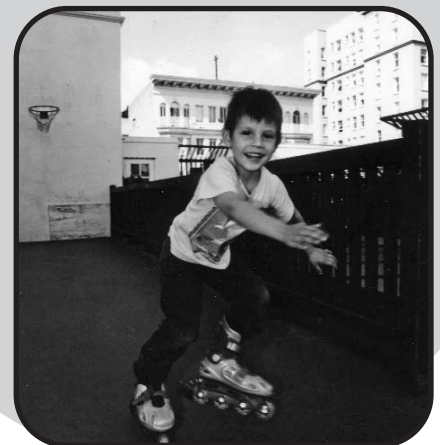
