

WHO WE ARE

The mission of Raphael House is to help low-income families and families experiencing homelessness strengthen family bonds by achieving stable housing and financial independence. Since 1971, Raphael House has been at the forefront of providing families in the San Francisco Bay Area personalized family-centered solutions to build brighter, independent futures. Raphael House is a 501(c)(3) community-supported nonprofit organization. Our programs include:

RESIDENTIAL SHELTER PROGRAM

Our stable, home-like Residential Shelter provides families a warm and safe family-centered community. Each family is provided with their own private room, daily nutritious meals, and new clothing.

While at Raphael House and in our Bridge Program, families participate in case management, coaching and mentorship, career development, financial planning, and children's academic and extracurricular support services, which strengthen the whole family as they work toward achieving long-term stable housing and financial independence.

BRIDGE PROGRAM

Through our post-shelter Bridge Program, we are committed to helping families reach and maintain long-term stability by supporting them with the resources and connections they need to move beyond poverty.

After families leave our shelter and join our Bridge Program, they have access to the same services they had while in shelter that help them overcome barriers to maintaining housing and achieving financial stability.




