

## **BACK TO SCHOOL FACT SHEET**

### **WHY YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS**

- 230,443 K-12 students—about 1 in 25 statewide—experienced homelessness this school year, a 9.3% percent jump from 2023.
- Students experiencing homelessness are **8.2% less likely to** graduate high school.
- The 2024 city count logged 1,196 homeless youth, with 823 still unsheltered.
- Families expect to spend an average \$875 per child on back-to-school items in 2024.
- Students who change schools frequently—common among unhoused families—score lower in math and face higher grade-retention rates.

100% of students in tutoring demonstrated improved academic performance

100% of students in tutoring demonstrated improved social-emotional behaviors

families have been served by Children's Services (375 children/teens)
